2021	4 GRAPPOLI	BIBENDA	Ruby red with purple highlights. The nose is vegetal and fruity, recalling green bell pepper, sour cherries and plum jam, with notes of pine needles and balsamic hints, powdery nuances, fresh violet and green coffee. Toasted and vanilla notes complete the bouquet. Full and savory on the palate, with well-integrated tannins and a pleasant balsamic-vegetal finish. Very persistent.
2018	96	LUCA MARONI	Its extraordinary extract makes it virtually impenetrable to the eye. Layer upon layer of deep pigmentation cloaks its essential character in richness and velvety texture. The bouquet is dense, profound and powerful: on one hand it captivates with intensity, while on the other it reveals exquisite balsamic nuances, ripe fruit and refined oak notes that radiate remarkable fragrance. Elegance reigns supreme, with a harmonious balance between softness and tannic structure, supported by impeccable winemaking precision that allows its majestic aromatic expression to shine through with clarity.
